trb s national cooperative highway research program nchrp report 684 enhancing internal trip capture estimation for mixed use developments explores an improved methodology to estimate how many internal trips will be generated in mixed use developments trips for which both the origin and destination are within the development the methodology estimates morning and afternoon peak period trips to and from six specific land use categories office retail restaurant residential cinema and hotel the research team analyzed existing data from prior surveys and collected new data at three mixed use development sites the resulting methodology is incorporated into a spreadsheet model which is available online for download

in this book bowes and krutilla bring together what is known and relevant about valuing the nonmarket services of the public forests and propose a new theoretical framework that allows multiple uses the biological dynamics of the forest and the institutional and economic realities of public forest management to be taken into account in forest planning and budgeting the authors begin by tracing the development of multiple use in forest management and by exploring the multiple uses of the public forests and the economics of multiple use forestry they offer a masterful analysis of the nineteenth century model of the single timber stand on which much forestry practice has been premised bowes and krutilla then take a giant step forward by developing a larger theoretical framework and showing how forest structure and dynamics can be included in the economic model the authors rigorous exposition theory provides the foundation for analyzing case studies of management for timber and water yields in the rockies of recreation valuation in the black hills and white mountain national forests and of joint production in the white clouds peaks analyses that demonstrate the authors great skill in developing practical methodologies to meet actual forest management problems

arendt explains how to design residential developments that maximize land conservation without reducing overall building density thus avoiding the political and legal problems often associated with down zoning the author offers a three pronged strategy for shaping growth around a community s special natural and cultural features demonstrating ways of establishing or modifying the municipal comprehensive plan zoning ordinance and subdivision ordinance to include a strong conservation focus open space protection becomes the central organizing principle for new residential development and the open space that is protected is laid out to form an interconnected system of protected lands running across a community the book offers detailed information on how to conduct a community resource inventory a four step approach to designing conservation subdivisions extensive model language for comprehensive plans subdivision ordinances and zoning ordinances illustrated design principles for hamlets villages and traditional small town neighborhoods in addition growing greener includes eleven case studies of actual conservation developments in nine states and two exercises suitable for group participation case studies include ringfield chadds ford township pennsylvania the fields of st croix city of lake elmo minnesota prairie crossing grayslake illinois the meadows at dolly gordon brook york maine farmcolony standsville virginia the ranch at roaring fork carbondale colorado and others growing greener builds upon and expands the basic ideas presented in arendt s earlier work conservation design for subdivisions broadening the scope to include more detailed sections on the comprehensive planning process and information on how zoning ordinances can be updated to incorporate the concept of conservation design it is the first practical publication to explain in detail how resource conserving development techniques can be put into practice by municipal officials residential developers and site designers and it offers a simple and straightforward approach to balancing opportunities for developers and conservationists

a clear and practical examination of complex issues local economic development and the environment finding common ground provides a broad academic look at the intersection of two important areas for local administrators in addition to managing development in a strained economic climate most administrators are also expected to be stewards of the environment however economic conditions often leave them with limited options for pursuing economic development and at the same time being environmentally mindful many find themselves without a clear understanding of the concepts tools and best practices available to accomplish this herculean task translating

the effects of thinning emory oak *quercus emoryi* coppice on transpiration have been estimated by the heat pulse velocity hpv method rootstocks of trees harvested for fuelwood were thinned to one two or three dominant stump sprouts or left as unthinned controls differences in transpiration rates of the thinned coppice were found for each treatment and the control earlier research has also shown that thinning of emory oak stump sprouts influences the growth and volume of the residual coppice and

its value for wildlife habitats therefore a decision matrix is presented to help in the management of thinned emory oak coppice for optimal combinations of water wood and wildlife benefits
